

## FACT SHEET

- 1) SPONSOR: Port Royal Bicentennial Planning Committee also known as PORT ROYAL 200. Contact person for the Committee and Brick Project: Carlen McClure, 816 Main Street, Port Royal, PA 17082 (717-527-9910).
- 2) MAILING ADDRESS FOR ORDERS: PORT ROYAL 200, 311 East Fifth Street, Port Royal, PA 17082
- 3) TYPES OF ENGRAVED BRICKS: There are three types of engraved bricks/pavers:
  - The most common type is an 8" x 4" (2  $^{1}/_{4}$ " thick) paver with three lines of inscription and a limit of fifteen characters per line. (Characters include letters, numbers, punctuation marks and spaces.) The inscription is created with a laser technology. The cost per paver is \$40.
  - A less common type is an 8" x 8" paver with four lines of inscription and a limit of fifteen characters per line. (Characters include letters, numbers, punctuation marks and spaces.) The inscription is created with a lazer technology. The cost per paver is \$100. It is assumed that this larger type of paver will appeal to organizations and businesses within the community.
  - The third type of brick is for personal commemoration purposes. It can only be ordered along with one of the regular 8" x 4" pavers. Although it will have the same surface size of the regular 8" x 4" paver, it will be only 1/2" thick. (Sometimes this type of brick is used as a veneer on a concrete base.) This commemorative paver can be used as a paper weight or door stop or a garden ornament. Unlike the other pavers, this paver will not be placed on the site at Port Royal but will instead be shipped to the person placing the order as a commemorative paver is \$35 per paver.
- 4) SITE OF THE BRICKS: The inscribed pavers/bricks will be placed in four rectangular plots at the site of the former Airy View Academy, Port Royal High School and Tuscarora Valley High School. The Port Royal Borough Council owns the land and has given permission to have the pavers at this location. The pavers will be accessible throughout the Bicentennial celebration and hopefully for many years thereafter.
- 5) PLACING PAVERS: The Borough Council has agreed to place blank pavers in the rectangular areas so that the plots will not look unfinished until all of the inscribed pavers are sold. As orders are placed, they will be held so that they can be grouped with other orders and then sent for the engraving process.

Once a group of pavers has been engraved and returned, they will be inserted in place of some of the blank pavers that are already in place.

- 6) SALES GOAL: The Committee believes that it will be able to fund all of its planned activities for the Bicentennial celebration if it can sell about 1,000 engraved pavers.
- 7) HOPEFUL PURCHASERS: The Committee will try to market the pavers to all those who currently have and whose ancestors have had a sense of pride in and affiliation with Port Royal and the surrounding community.
  - We consider the Port Royal community to include both the borough and the surrounding townships. Throughout our history, the borough and surrounding townships have been interdependent upon each other.
  - Although the permanent site for the pavers is the former home of the high school, this project is intended for all no matter where they went to school.
  - It is hoped that people will purchase pavers for both themselves and for their ancestors. This project is not to just commemorate past residents of the community but all who have had or currently have a sense of pride in Port Royal.
  - People can purchase pavers not just for themselves and their relatives, they can also purchase pavers for those who have played a significant role in their lives. (Teacher, coach, minister, service person, friend, or someone they feel has made a special contribution to Port Royal.)

## 8) PROJECT ADVANTAGES:

It is a way to show pride in the Port Royal community.

- It is a way to remember our rich heritage and evolving present.
- It can continue throughout the planning of the bicentennial and isn't limited by a special dated activity.
- It can look completed from the beginning and throughout the brick selling process.
- It is not constrained by the requirement for a minimum order and thus will produce no left-over inventory.

It is a type of project that hasn't already saturated the Juniata County area.

## 9) PLACING AN ORDER: (Please place an order, we need your support.)

Print and mail one of the two forms that follow to place your order. NOTE THAT THE FIRST FORM IS FOR THE \$40 BRICK and THE SECOND IS FOR THE \$100 BRICK.

Use a separate form for each brick ordered. Don't place more than one order on a form. (However more than one form can be mailed in an envelope.)
